

GSO Senate Resolution 13.04

A Resolution to Extend Outdoor Education Discount Rates to Graduate Students

Whereas, Recreation Services charges graduate students a higher rate than undergraduates to go on Outdoor Education trips and is not able to extend the same pricing to graduate students without financial support; and

Whereas, graduate students filled over 125 of the slots for these trips, and paid over an additional \$1700 in fees compared to undergraduate; and

Whereas, Outdoor Education trips allow students to expand their learning opportunities outside of the classroom, and explore areas they may not otherwise be able to; and

Whereas, it is believed by Recreation Services that funding would allow an even greater number of graduate students to benefit from their Outdoor Education trips.

Resolved, That we allocate up to \$2000 for a pilot run of working with Recreation Services, that will be used to allow Recreation Services Outdoor Education to charge the same price for trips to graduate students as charged to undergraduate students. These funds will be used on a rolling basis as graduate students sign up for trips.
