

GSO Senate Resolution 13.06

A Resolution to Subsidize the Registration Fee for Graduate Students Who Wish to Take Part in the Tennity Learn To Skate Program

Whereas, the cost of the Tennity Learn to Skate program may be prohibitively high for graduate students, at a cost of \$75/semester; and

Whereas, the number of graduate students participating in the program is relatively small, and Recreation Services would like to see it increase; and

Whereas, the Director of Recreation Services, Joe Lore, has reached out to the GSO to request a subsidy of \$50 for ten students on the grounds that it would aid graduate students who wish to take part in this program and expand graduate student interest in the program; and

Whereas, the GSO stands to benefit considerably from a positive working relationship with Recreation Services, therefore be it

Resolved, That the GSO allocate \$500 to subsidize ten students' registration fees for the Tennity Learn to Skate Program. This will allow ten students to register for the program at a cost of \$25 and will serve to strengthen the relationship between the GSO and Recreation Services.
