



GSO Senate Resolution 13.11

A Resolution to Amend the GSO Constitution to Alter Executive Officer Term Limits

Whereas, term limits inherently limit voter choice, and

Whereas, the GSO traditionally has difficulty in finding candidates for officer positions, and

Whereas, the GSO requires considerable institutional memory to operate efficiently within a university with long time-horizon projects, and

Whereas, based on past experiences, some term limit controls are needed for the position of President and any positions that are compensated at a full time rate, and

Whereas, the GSO should lessen non-President term limits while strengthening term limits on GSO Presidents; therefore, be it

Resolved, That, effective April 22, 2013, Article II, Section 1 (vi) be made to read “No person shall serve more than two terms in any single position on the Executive Board.”

Current II.1(vi) language: “Officers may serve a maximum of three terms on the Executive Board.”
