



**GSO Senate Resolution 13.12**

**A Resolution to Amend the GSO Constitution to Alter College of Law  
Representation in the GSO Senate**

**Whereas**, the SBA of the Syracuse University College of Law has approved a measure to end the financial relationship between the SBA and GSO, and

**Whereas**, the representation of the SBA in the GSO Senate was originally predicated on the financial relationship, thus the Senate representation should be reverted to its original state; therefore be it

**Resolved**, That, effective May 1, 2013, Article I, Section 4 shall be amended to read: “Three Senators may be selected by the graduate students at SUNY-ESF. SUNY-ESF Senators have all rights and responsibilities of other GSO Senators but are not eligible to serve on the Executive Board.”

**Resolved**, That, effective May 1, 2013, Article VII, Section 4 shall be amended to read: “Graduate students at SUNY-ESF shall pay a portion of the total student fee as determined by the GSO Executive Board, in consultation with the SUNY-ESF GSA. The graduate students of SUNY-ESF are eligible to use services provided by the GSO, as determined by the Executive Board in consultation with the SUNY-ESF GSA.”

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Current I.4 language: “Three Senators may be selected by the graduate students at SUNY-ESF. Three Senators may be selected by the graduate students at the College of Law, in a manner determined by the Student Bar Association. SUNY-ESF and College of Law Senators have all rights and responsibilities of other GSO Senators but are not be eligible to serve on the Executive Board.”

Current VII.4 language: “Graduate students at SUNY-ESF and the College of Law shall pay a portion of the total student fee as determined by the GSO Executive Board, in consultation with said graduate student bodies. The graduate students of SUNY-ESF and the College of Law are eligible to use services provided by the GSO, as determined by the Executive Board in consultation with said graduate student bodies.”
