- 2. Finance Committee has begun to go over budgets for next year. This process will officially begin in February and budget proposals will need to be submitted by March 1st.
- 3. Special Programming

- Kidfest- neighborhood kids come into SU and see educational performances of what happens around the campus. Gives underserved children an experience on the hill. \$1500 was requested- **Finance Committee has recommended to fund in full- move to adopt recommendation- seconded- no debate- No objections- passes** 

- Women in Technology- \$400 requested- partnering with Whitman School to host on campus networking event for students to talk with local start-ups and other businesses- **Finance Committee recommend to fund in full- move to adopt recommendation- no debate- no objections- passes**

Nicole would like to recommend SU provide daily weekend busses for off campus students- move to adopt this idea- seconded- move to amend resolution- debate on amendment- amendment passed-move to strike weekend in third whereas- change passed- amendment as a whole passed
