- f. Report on Budget Surplus and Ideas for Rollover
 - i. All ideas for surplus budget spending were collected,
 - ii. The Board evaluated all ideas-feasibility and technicality
 - 1. The Board recommended certain ideas, the Finance committee will make the final recommendations in the spring and present at the first meeting of the Spring semester
 - iii. SU Doctoral Administrative Internships
 - 1. Employment for Doctorate student for alternative academic careers
 - 2. -10 hours of pay at GA rate
 - 3. Start with 3 positions
 - 4. Cost is 11K
 - 5. How does this effect int'l students?
 - a. All grad students will be able to apply for this position
 - 6. Health insurance?
 - a. This position does not include health benefits
 - 7. Can this be used for Summer also?
 - a. We can alter it for the Summer
 - 8. Speaking in favor-Two students are trying t get their organization off the ground. They have met with people, and collaborated with others? This is a great opportunity for Doctoral students to get practical experience.
 - 9. GA rate?
 - a. This is half of the standard GA rate
 - 10. The Board recommends this
 - iv. Dissertation Boot Camp
 - 1. Week ling program for 20-25 dissertators
 - 2. \$3000 for January pilot, \$7500 for May/June
 - 3. held in Bird Library
 - 4. The Board felt that there were other ways to carry this out-some universities hold meeting in libraries or quiet space with food, and having people help students with their dissertations

- a. The Board recommends the alternative
- 5. What would we do different?
 - a. We would not bring in outside experts
- v. Subvent Publication of Graduate School Press Book
 - 1. Print 400 copies at \$2025
 - 2. On-campus book-launch/mentoring event at \$6000
 - a. Workshops for grad students, junior faculty, program directors
 - b. Can be scaled back
 - 3. Sell book for \$19.95 or give out for free
 - 4. Question: What is the Book about?
 - a. Student mentoring continuum; theoretical tools for mentoring
 - 5. Are the authors from Syracuse University
 - a. IT is edited from Glenn Wright
 - 6. If we fund, they will add the GSO logo
 - 7. The Board was mixed on this recommendation
 - 8. Free or 19.95
 - a. Contractual obligations to sell through Glenn's office for 19.95
 - 9. Funding comes from some sources to publish books like this-they asked because they weren't able to get funding
 - 10. Patrick says that this is the book that they have tried to get GSO funding for this book in the past
 - 11. Book Launch
 - a. There are no details on this book launch
 - 12. Some students have read previous books, and they were more for FPP
 - 13. Motion to limit comments on slides to one minute
 - a. Vote
 - b. All in favor
 - 14. Motion to have someone come to defend this book; seconded
 - a. There is disagreement
 - 15. Call to question seconded
 - a. All in favor; motion carries
- vi. Video Captioning
 - 1. Grad School has 40 videos that need to be captioned in accordance with the ADA
 - 2. Pay: \$275 per 90-minute video
 - 3. View Counts are low (avg. 7, high:18)
 - 4. Full funding by GSO: 40 videos at \$11
 - 5. This seems like a high cost? What are the content of these videos?
 - a. Content includes events at Syracuse, and the videos need to be captioned to put up
- vii. Team teaching Internship
 - 1. For FPP participants at OCC, TC3, and other local teaching focused institutions
 - 2. \$2000 per students/course + \$500 Honorarium for co-teaching mentor
 - 3. Questions: How much is the budget? \$100K
 - 4. Will this be a range of subjects?
 - a. There can be criteria added for the content
- viii. SciPhD Certificate Program

- 1. 4-day professionalism prep program for 70-80 STEM doctoral students
- 2. Would be a pilot program this year
- 3. Total cost \$2500
- 4. The Board was divided on this recommendation
- 5. When the Finance committee comes back there should be more information
- ix. Update GSO website, forms, travel grant
 - 1. Hire grad student to update these documents
 - 2. Revisit travel grant requirements
 - 3. Funs one-year fellowship (this year) or aloe for larger grants
 - 4. Forms are through Frevvo-because it is safe for student information
 - 5. Board was undecided on
- x. Various proposals together
 - 1. Forgo collection of additional dues until rollover reaches an appropriate level
 - 2. Place surplus in interest-bearing account each year to generate additional revenue
 - 3. Return rollover to due-paying members
 - 4. Endowment is not an option
- xi. Increase travel grants
 - 1. Increase number of awards; max allotment (\$600
 - 2. Eliminate stipulations that students apply for alternative funding before applying to the GSO
 - 3. Board recommends this
 - 4. Would other funding be having schools report that there is no funding for their students
- xii. Creating grant program for Job Search
 - 1. Offer stipend up to \$500 for travel expenses, professional attire
 - 2. Problem is that we cannot follow to see if the funds are used appropriately
 - 3. This is to help student looking for jobs
- xiii. Create Grant Program for Dissertation
 - 1. Offer \$300 stipend to help with final steps of completing documents
 - 2. Could include: Printing and distribution, securing copyright
 - 3. We may be able to talk to libraries about printing and helping with publishing dissertations
 - 4. There are universities that have a lottery funding process
 - Schools are moving away from printing, going to EMI to publish
 a. One dissertation must be printed
 - 6. Board does not recommend
- xiv. Various proposals
 - 1. Add more GSO activities
 - 2. Increase Travel Grant to \$400
 - a. We are increasing the travel grant-that's one of the recommendations
 - 3. There are more activities
 - 4. Contributing money to the Grad Dean for graduate students
 - 5. Board recommends

- xv. Establishing funds for childcare
 - 1. Giving single parents the time to attend evening lectures
 - 2. The GSO is working on childcare for grad students
 - 3. Putting together an ad-hoc committee to help with childcare
- xvi. Expand Travel Grant
- xvii. Funding Inter-Dept. Speaker Series
 - 1. Providing funds to support speakers
- xviii. Offer Workshop series with Wendy Welcher
 - 1. Focus o writing and publishing journal articles
 - 2. Board doesn't recommend this-we already fund something similar
 - 3. How does this fall under Career service?
 - a. The most relevant outside of Grad services
 - 4. Workshop in this area is valid, but too specific
 - 5. Motion to extend for a minute; seconded
 - a. Nay-motion finals
- xix. Set-up Dept. wide Career Services
 - 1. Creating Career service for graduate students within departments
 - 2. Board doesn't recommend-it isn't feasible
 - 3. However; this is apart of the Strategic Plan
- xx. Clinical Simulation for I-TA's
 - 1. Use Upstate Clinical Skills center to simulate scenarios for Int'l TA to handle situations in real time
 - 2. Cost: \$2500 for 40 I-TAs enrolled in ENL 610
 - 3. Three days in Mid-February
 - 4. Fees for actors, video recording, group debriefing
 - 5. Board does recommend
 - 6. Students think that this is a good idea
 - 7. SA is asking to collaborate with us for assisted TA trainings for domestic and Int'l TAs-we will be reaching out to SA
- xxi. Twitter
 - 1. Bus systems
 - a. Working on this
 - b. Put more public pressure on the bus system
 - 2. Psychological Help
 - a. University responsibility-GSO is working with them
 - 3. Daycare Center Funding
 - a. Will have a committee
 - 4. Grant subsidies
 - a. Include in travel grant
 - 5. Convention dues
 - a. We don't have a union
- xxii. NAGPS Leadership Summit
 - 1. 3-day event with grad representatives from other institutions
 - 2. Cost: \$5-7K
 - 3. Need to propose by January
 - 4. Budget \$10k to be safe
 - 5. Newhouse could host the Event
 - 6. Would need at least 10 volunteers for whole event

- 7. What's the time duration for volunteers
 - a. In the morning and in he afternoon
- 8. There should be a decision on this now, because the NAGPS board meeting in early January before classes start
