



GSO Senate Resolution 17.01

A Resolution to Lower the Maximum Cap for GSO Travel Grant Awards

Whereas, in the 2015-16 academic year, 230 students earned Travel Grant Awards, which averaged at \$363.41 for a total amount of \$83,583; and

Whereas, due to previous increase in the maximum award to \$600, the average award will be significantly higher than \$363.41, which may result in the Travel Grant Program budget running out earlier than anticipated; and

Whereas, the Travel Grant program is likely to run out of allocated funds before the final application deadline of this academic year; and

Whereas, this will also allow the Travel Grant Committee to award higher number of travel grants; therefore, be it

Resolved, that the Senate decrease the maximum award cap from \$600 to \$500, amending Travel Grant Policy section II.c.v to read "Travel Grants shall be no more than \$500. Applicants may receive less than \$500. Applicants may be denied funding."
