



**GSO Senate Resolution 16.02**

**A Resolution Concerning GSO Funding of the Slutzker Center for International Students, Relating to Resolution 15.20 (The Annual Budget)**

**Whereas**, Resolution 15.20, the GSO Annual Budget, line B.9 allocated \$19,642 for the Slutzker Center under the conditions of stipulation 16, which required that “The Slutzker Center for International Services shall only receive the approved funds once a committee is formed and begins meeting to study long-term orientation funding restructuring within the Division of Student Affairs (DSA)”;

**Whereas**, the GSO President has stated that the Dean and SVP of Student Affairs, Rebecca Reed Kantrowitz, has agreed in principle that orientation programming funding should not come from student fee money, the underlying dispute in this matter, and therefore the allocated funds were transmitted to the Slutzker Center; and

**Whereas**, the GSO Senate would like additional, written assurance from the Dean that the funding of orientation programming is a university obligation; therefore be it

**Resolved**, that the GSO requests that the Dean and SVP of Student Affairs confirm in writing that the university will fund all appropriate graduate student orientation programming undertaken by the Division of Student Affairs for the coming years without requesting graduate student activity fee funds for such activities, unless such activities go above and beyond normal orientation programming and serve as “value added” additional programming.
