



Online Executive Session Rules of Conduct

The Chair moves to adopt the following rules for February 17th's online Executive Session for the Appointment of a Committee on Impeachment...

- (1) Only recognized members of the deliberative assembly may attend this meeting per *RONR* executive session laws regarding disciplinary procedures.
 - a. Attendees will log on from a secure location that ensures the meeting's privacy.
 - b. Non-members, or those deemed unable to attend by the assembly, will not attend through a recognized member's Zoom channel, and members will not facilitate such actions.
- (2) Attendees will not photograph or record any portion of this meeting.
- (3) Attendees will keep their camera on. Those who cannot have their camera on must state so to the Co-Host and are permitted to have their camera off.
 - a. If attendees must turn their camera off momentarily, they must notify the Co-Host in Direct Message.
 - b. Attendees with cameras off for more than 5-minutes will be removed from the meeting.
- (4) Attendees will not transmit details of this meeting to non-members of the deliberative assembly either verbally or in writing.
- (5) The penalty for breaking the above rules shall be removal from the meeting, permanent censure for the record, and further penalties the assembly decides.
- (6) Attendees who cause dilatory disruptions will be called to order. Attendees who persist in causing dilatory disruptions will be muted temporarily and possibly removed from the meeting.
